NDA

The National Defence Academy is the most premier Defence Academy in Asia. The foundation of NDA was laid at Khadakwasla (Pune) by Pt Jawaharlal Nehru on 06 Oct 1949. The first course commenced its training at Clement Town near Dehradun as a wing of Indian Military Academy on 17 Jan 49. The first course passed out on 08 Dec 50. The formal inauguration on NDA at its present location was held on 16 Jan 55. The first Commandant of NDA was Major General Thakur Mahadeo Singh, DSO (from 01 Jan 49 to 12 Mar 50).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

For admission in to the Army, Navy and Airforce wings of the Indian Armed Forces there is a prestigious all India examination called The National Defence Academy (NDA) Entrance Examination conducted by the UPSC twice in a year in the month of April and September.

Qualification: 12th / II-year student or passed

Age: 16 years 6 months to 19 years 6 months

Notification: May/June and Nov/December

How to apply: On line using website <http://www.upsconline.nic.in>

Selection criteria: Qualify written exam, SSB interview and Medical exam

Structure of written Exam:

Paper I : Mathematics, 300 marks, duration 2hours 30 minutes

Paper II : General Ability Test, 600 marks, duration 2.30 hours

TECHNICAL ENTRY SCHEME (TES) ARMY

Permanent commission for male candidates only.

Age limit: 16 and half to 19 and half.

Educational qualification: passed 10+2 exam with a minimum aggregate of 70% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Maths.

Selection Procedure: Candidates will be shortlisted and called directly for SSB interview on the basis of cut-off % of marks, which is decided by the Army Headquarters every year. (Last year's cut-off was 86%)

How to apply: Candidates are required to register on website:

When to apply: June/ July and November/December (Twice a year)

NAVY 10+2 (B TECH) ENTRY

Four-year Degree course under the 10+2(B Tech) cadet entry scheme, Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala, Kerala.

Age: 16 and half to 19 and half

Educational Qualification: Passed 12th with 70% aggregate marks in PCM and 50% marks in English either in 10th or 12th

Who can apply: 12th student or 12th passed, must appear JEE(mains). Will be called for SSB interview based on All India Rank in JEE.

How to apply: Candidates are to register and submit application on website www.joinindiannavy.gov.in

Documents required:

- (a) Date of Birth proof (10th/12th certificate)
 - (b) 10th mark sheet
 - (c) 12th mark sheet
 - (d) JEE main score card
 - (e) Recent passport size photograph
- (All in pdf format)

When to apply: May/June and November/ December
